#### **4 FIRST AID MEASURES**

### 4.1 Description of first aid measures

#### General

Immediately take off contaminated clothing and wash it before reuse.

# **Inhalation**

Move the exposed person to fresh air at once. If respiratory problems, provide artificial respiration/oxygen. Get medical attention.
